Pre-Algebra

Saxon Algebra $\frac{1}{2}$

Students learn and practice fractions, decimals, mixed numbers, signed numbers, numbers in base 2, arithmetic operations, involving all these forms of numbers, order of operations, percents, proportions, use of variables and terms, ratios, divisibility, rounding, place value, unit conversions, scientific notation, and word problems involving these pre-algebraic concepts. Also included are geometric concepts and topic such as perimeter, area, surface area, volume, classification of geometric figures and solids, geometric constructions, and symmetry.
