

- ❖ Kindergarten is a full day program which follows our K4 -12<sup>th</sup> grade calendar.
- ❖ Class begins at 8:20 a.m. and concludes at 3:15 p.m.
- ❖ In addition to a qualified teacher, a teacher's aide assists throughout the day.
- ❖ Classes begin with a Bible lesson. They will study the Life of Christ, the Salvation series, and missionary stories.
- ❖ The ABeka Christian curriculum is used to teach solid academic subjects in Phonics, Numbers, Art, and Science.
- ❖ Students will learn the alphabet and their sounds.
- ❖ Blends and vowel rules are taught with reading groups.
- ❖ They will learn numbers up to 100.
- ❖ They will learn to count by 1's, 2's, 5's, and 10's and will also learn addition facts in the 10's family.
- ❖ They will learn shapes, colors, opposites, and to be community helpers.
- ❖ The daily routine includes a play time, snack time, lunch and nap time.
- ❖ They will have a weekly choir, P.E., and art time.
- ❖ They will be reading simple books by the end of the year.
- ❖ Daily writing time with letters and numbers.
- ❖ They will be introduced to cursive writing.
- ❖ Students have a graduation with cap, gown, and diploma at the end of the school year.
